Office of Safe Environment ...

Safe Environment training is taking place in all dioceses in the United States. To date, here in the Diocese of Richmond, over 57,200 adults have received training to recognize, respond to and report child abuse with over 150 individual facilitators leading those trainings. Since October 2004, the Diocese has held over 3200 VIRTUS training sessions for adults; in 2018, 292 training sessions were held.

Working alongside the Bishop, the Office of Safe Environment reinforces the ongoing implementation of policies and procedures that protect children and the vulnerable. Safe Environment policies and procedures are updated every year enabling the office to provide more support for and greater flexibility in assisting survivors of abuse.

During the most recent audit period, for 2017-18, the diocese reported 32,103 active Safe Environment participants including all clergy, parish and school employees and volunteers who work with minors.
