Wondering which Faith Formation program is right for you & your family???

- **Pre-K3 to Grade 5** All children ages 3 through 5th grade and their parents are invited to join our **Family Faith Formation** program. Parents meet for fellowship and faith sharing while their children attend age level classes. This year we will be meeting on the **3rd Sunday of each month** from **9:30 AM to 10:45 AM** beginning September 19th. A suggested donation of \$20 per child to cover the cost of materials would be most appreciated.
- **Grades 6 to 12** All youth in 6th through 12th grade are invited to deepen their understanding of the Faith by joining our **Youth Faith Formation** program. Depending on the topic, middle and high school students may meet together or separately. This year we will be meeting on the **3rd Sunday of each month** from **6:00 PM to 7:30 PM** beginning September 19th. A suggested donation of \$20 per youth to cover the cost of materials would be most appreciated.
- ALL Middle and High School Students regardless of religious affiliation are invited to join our Youth Group for social justice activities, prayer experiences, guest speakers and social activities within our parish, region and diocese. We meet on the 2nd & 4th Sundays of each month. We begin with our Youth Mass at 5 PM and meet until 8 PM usually in Ashland House.
- Adults We currently have two on-going weekly opportunities for ALL adults to grow in their Faith:
 - Our Spirit of God Prayer Group meets on Thursday evenings from 7 to 8:30 p.m. in the Church Commons for praise & worship, fellowship and Scripture study. Beginning September 2nd, they will be doing a 4 part series on the Eucharist using "Presence, The Mystery of the Eucharist".
 - Our **Curious about the Catholic Faith Group** is for all adults who would like to know more about the Catholic Faith including those who are thinking of becoming Catholic (RCIA) and those who were baptized but never made their 1st Communion or Confirmation. This group meets on **Sunday mornings** from **9:30 AM to 10:45** in the church Welcome Center.
- **ALL** children and teens preparing for 1st Reconciliation, 1st Communion and Confirmation must attend either a Catholic school or our Family/Youth Faith Formation program. Additional classes specific to preparing for these Sacraments are also required.



SACRAMENTS

- **Reconciliation** is available on Saturday afternoons from 3:30 to 5 p.m. and by appointment.
- Baptisms are currently being held immediately after any Sunday liturgy. Families are expected to attend the Mass, then gather around the baptismal font for the baptism. All Diocesan/CDC guidelines are followed.
- 1st Communion Preparation is offered twice a year.
 The next set of classes will begin November 9th. Full details will be in the October Newsletter. Families must be attending Mass in person before a 1st Communion will be scheduled.
- Funerals and Weddings currently have no seating and capacity restrictions but masks are highly encouraged.
