BAPTISM

For Confirmation preparation of teenagers, please contact our Youth Minister. For Baptism of older children and adults, all First Communion preparation and Confirmation of adults, please contact our director of Faith Formation. Adults who are considering becoming Catholic are invited to participate in our RCIA program.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Please call the office at least six months in advance to set dates, make arrangements for instruction and for planning the ceremony. Marriage Preparation for the couple is a requirement.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

Scheduled on Saturdays, 3:30-5:00 p.m. in the church or by appointment

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

This sacrament is administered on request to those who are ill at home, undergoing surgery, are in the hospital, or in a nursing home.

Golden Jubilee for Sr. Rose Pacatte

This weekend on Saturday, June 25th at the 5:30 P.M. Mass, we remember Sr. Rose Pacatte in our Mass Intentions. Sr. Rose is celebrating her 50th Jubilee as a Daughter of St. Paul in Culver City, California on this day. She entered religious life in Boston on August 5, 1967, made first profession on June 25, 1972 and final vows on June 25, 1978.

This past winter, we received a wonderful letter from Sr. Rose along with copies of documents from her baptism on December 2, 1951 at Christ the King. In her letter, she noted that she was born in Portsmouth on November 19, 1951, but moved from the area in May 1952 due to military orders. She checked Google Earth and her home on Lafayette Blvd. is gone now—it's just an empty lot. She then went on to say: "My desire is to let the parish community know that the seed of my vocation was planted at my baptism at Christ the King Parish all those years ago. I imagine that everyone from those days has moved or is entering eternity but know that I remain deeply grateful for my baptism at Christ the King. It is my prayer that everyone will realize how wonderful our Baptism is, when the DNA of our faith life is set afire by the sacramental grace."

A letter of congratulations along with a gift was sent to her on behalf of the parish in May and a poster is in the Commons with a display of the information she sent us.

GROW AS A DISCIPLE | PRAY, STUDY, ENGAGE, SERVE

Members of our family joke that saying goodbye after a family gathering needs to begin about an hour before we plan to leave. Goodbyes mean hugs for every family member, and there are many of us! We are aware of how precious our loved ones are to us, and so Jesus' response to the person who asks if he can first say farewell to his family may seem perplexing to us. But in this reading, Luke presents Jesus as "resolutely" headed to Jerusalem because "the days for Jesus' being taken up were fulfilled." Jesus is ready to complete the mission he came for and anyone who wants to follow him can't be distracted by indecision. His matter-of-fact answers are directed at newcomers who seem to hesitate when he invites them to follow him. He wants his disciples to know that being a disciple will have an impact on personal comfort, and that everything one does – for family, loved ones, or whomever – must flow from this discipleship *first*. It is not about ignoring other responsibilities, but carrying them out in light of who we are and whom we follow. Jesus calls us to make our relationship with him our highest priority. Doing so will bring life to all the relationships we value as we grow to live and love like him.

INVITE Ask the Holy Spirit to help you discern who needs the gift of your presence in their life right now. Schedule time with this person, just listening, affirming their gifts, and assuring them of your belief in them and God's love for them.

GO EVANGELIZE

PRAYER, INVITATION, WITNESS, ACCOMPANIMENT

How do we commit to answering God's call without hesitation? Like the first Apostles, the prosperous farmer Elisha in today's first reading willingly responded to the call from Elijah. But he didn't just leave everything and go: He first burned his plow as fuel in order to cook the oxen and leave it for his people to eat. In following the Lord, his first act was to ensure that those for whom he was responsible were not left without. Answering God's call is not often easy. But like Elisha and the Apostles, we are called to listen and respond to the ways God calls us and to trust in his Spirit to guide us. As Paul tells the Galatians, we are to "live by the Spirit." By trusting in the power of the Holy Spirit and turning to him for strength and guidance, we can be Christ's presence wherever he leads us – and doing whatever it entails.

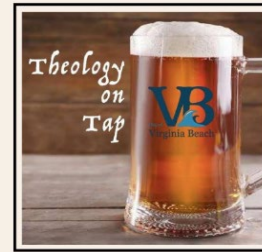
